#### PROPHET ELIAS

Prophet Elias, (Elijah), was wise and faithful to the true God. God sent him to speak the truth to King Ahab and his evil wife Jezebel. Not only did King Ahab not listen to Prophet Elias, but he threatened to kill him. Prophet Elias fled to a mountain where he stayed and hid in a cave. Prophet Elias had prophesied that it would last for 3 years as a punishment for the faithlessness of King Ahab and Queen Jezebel. So, in time, the stream dried up.
